In order to do so he will have to trust a lousy poet of a dog and a stray one, and the enigmatic Berenice, a black cat who keeps too many secrets. In his adventure, Lilo will also face his worst fear: exposing his chubby body and his short legs to Muriel.

His courage comes from the love he feels for his pack of humans: the girl and her grandparents. Thanks to his sense of smell, Lilo not only finds out the source of his mistress' grief. He also reflects on the strange reactions of human beings, their insensitivity towards each other and the ways in which they neglect a world full of prodigies.
